Please follow the rules and regulations below to enter the Florida Reading Association (FRA) Reading Poster Contest.

## Reading Poster Contest Rules and Regulations

- 1. Posters will only use the reading slogans and rubric provided for this contest.
- 2. Only original artwork is permitted. Clipart, photocopies, or tracings incorporated in the poster will not be accepted. Fragile media, i.e. pastel, charcoal, graphite, must be sealed with fixative.
- 3. All posters must be vertical format, 18" X 12", unmatted and 2 dimensional.
- 4. Each participating school will select the one best poster.
- 5. Mail the poster in a mailing tube or flat (not folded). Creased or folded posters will not be accepted.
- 6. All posters must be received by Monday, April 7<sup>th</sup>.
- 7. Fill out the label and affix to the back of the poster in the lower left corner.
- 8. Fill out and sign the Artwork and Photographic Release Form and include it with entry.
- 9. By submitting an entry, each contestant and his/her parent/legal guardian agree: they have read, understand, and comply with these official rules, that entries become the permanent property of FRA and cannot be returned, that FRA or SRC is not responsible for loss or damage to entry, that entry may be reproduced for advertising purposes without further consent, compensation or approval.
